# Linq Chair Series Adjustments

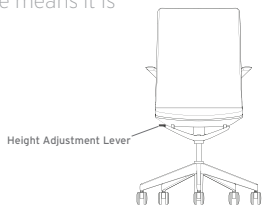
## Height Adjustment

The right-hand lever (sitting in chair) actuates the gas lift mechanism.

- To **raise** height: Lift the lever while lifting your weight from the chair. The chair will follow your body up. Release the lever and the new height position will be held.
- To **lower** height: Lift the same lever while sitting in the chair. Let the chair move down with your weight and release the lever at the desired height.

### ***Tips regarding height adjustment:***

Find the height at which your feet are flat on the floor and the back of your thighs are comfortably supported by the seat cushion. Too much pressure on the back of your thighs means the chair is too high; too little pressure means it is too low.



## Back & Seat Adjustment

There is no need for back and seat adjustment. Linq's design is centered upon a mechanism that follows the body's natural movement with a simple, intelligent structure that can adapt to the user's form and weight.

## Knit Cleaning Instructions

- Under no circumstances should knit be scrubbed forcefully.
- Fresh stains can usually be removed quickly by wiping immediately with an absorbent, lint-free sponge or cloth.
- When wiping a stain, start from the outer edge of the stain and work towards the center to avoid creating a halo effect.
- Water may be used if needed
- For daily care, a vacuum may be used for dust or lint removal.

### **Treatment of more stubborn stains:**

- Always pretest a small, inconspicuous area before proceeding.
- Use a soft white cloth (cloth must be white) soaked with a solution of transparent hair shampoo (for sensitive hair) and water. Additional dyes in the cloth or shampoo may stain the knit.
